FABIFA (Valeryia Losikava)

Born and raised in conservative Belarus, I discovered a new-found freedom when moving to Berlin in 2015. The city's open attitude provided a perfect platform for self-discovery and reflection which I show within my art.

My work captures harmonious moments, aiming to reflect my subject's sensations and feelings, in a perspective from which I am in control. A further focal point is my aesthetic preference and perception of beauty.

I use tape art as a protest, as an expression of my personal and sexual freedom. I see most of my art as a tool of communication that is supposed to raise awareness to justice, equality and self-xpression.

STATEMENT

My work brings up social and cultural questions, by examining traditional, popular and subcultures, notions of freedom and how these influence and form society. I close the gap between social stereotypes and open new ways for people to perceive different cultures in a globalized world.

Graphic rawness and clarity of lines are delivered through the properties of tape, my primary medium. My preference to this aesthetics was subconsciously influenced by propaganda art and later in life, in stark contrast, by pop and comic art. Ironically the function of tape to 'stick together' or bond lends itself perfectly in combining two opposing sources of inspiration. Essentially, my purpose as an artist is to embody the tape's characteristics to make bonds and unite different ideas. Furthermore my recent color palette has been greatly influenced by Ultraviolet glowing corals and sea creatures in correlation with the urban night life of a modern metropolis. Human existence and perception are at the center of my work with the exploration of creating a blueprint of the future human.

TAPE ART

Tape art is a form of contemporary art that involves the use of adhesive tapes, such as duct tape, electrical tape, or masking tape, to create images, designs, and patterns on various surfaces, including walls, floors, and canvases. Tape art is a relatively new art form that gained popularity in the early 2000s. It is a versatile medium that can be used to create large-scale murals or small-scale pieces, and can be easily removed or altered without damaging the surface it's applied to, but also remains reliable and undamaged for a long time. Tape art has been used for various purposes, including advertising campaigns, public art installations and interior design.

CYBERBASE

The interactive installation "Cyberbase" consists of a tape art, light and sound projection onto it. The artwork depicts Van Gogh living in a modern world and endowed with modern capabilities. Van Gogh has a cyber implant in place of a severed ear and a modified arm, smokes a vaporizer that reflects his wellbeing. The City on the background: The artwork is a physical tape art interpretation of the virtual Cyberbase, which is created by artist Aetherways in virtual reality, presented on the opposite side of our room in Game Over Berlin

The city was created with the mood and neon colors of modern night Tokyo with elements of Cyber reality. Viewer can communicate with the installation by pressing the buttons on the floor embedded in the image of the microchip with hands. By clicking on parts of the microchip (made with cooper tape, viewer can turn on individual parts of the installation, light-sound projection is launched and feel involved in the reality of this created city and can also communicate with the portrait of Van Gogh. The installation virtual reality prepares YOU to enter additionally, allowing the use of different senses, not just vision. The animated projection for the installation will be created by the artist Tiziano Mirabella.



MONA LISA (CYBERBASE)


Rethinking old images will help a modern person to become better in the future without losing touch with the past.

Initially, I wanted to revisit the classic image of the famous painting. For many, Mona Lisa is just a mystical image of a beauty captured by a famous artist. I wanted to free her from objectification and to remind us that Mona Lisa was a real person and to endow her with the freedoms that I now have, living in modern Berlin. As a girl from Belarus who moved to Berlin, I personally discovered many freedoms that I didn't have before. Thus, the topic of freedom has become the main theme in my work. With this artwork I wanted to reflect the ideas of freedom of expression. I imagined how she lives among us in modern Berlin and has all the possibilities that she did not have at her time, and I imagined how Lisa Gherardini would like to look now.

I chose tape as a modern material. The use of new non-standard materials allows us to expand the boundaries of the viewer's perception. It is my hope that this will show the viewer new possibilities and open up new ways of perceiving art. The works made of tape can be touched and thus add tactility to the visual impressions. Also, the use of different light and light effects allows you to enhance the impact on the viewer.












